Problem	Reason	Solution
Has not removed all of the stain.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not mixed with correct Aqua-Seal STS™ product. • Surface is sealed. • Stain is too deep. • Poultice not applied for long enough. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check Aqua-Seal STS™ literature to ascertain correct cleaner to mix with Poultice Powder™. • Remove existing sealer with Strip-It™ before application of Poultice. • Stain too deep and perhaps permanent. • Apply Poultice for 24 hours and stain may require more than one treatment.
Lightens tone of surface.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Poultice has removed general dirt as well as the contaminant thus lightening the tone of the treated area. • Poultice residue not completely removed from surface. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always apply Poultice to complete piece of stone or tile and not just the stain itself. • Clean any residue with water. If it has cured and gone hard, clean with water and Aqua-Seal STS™ MicroScrub™.
Visible residue on surface or in grout.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residue not completely removed from surface. • Porous grout may have absorbed Poultice. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean any residue with water. If it has cured and gone hard, try cleaning with water and Aqua-Seal STS™ MicroScrub™. • Re-colour stained grout with Aqua-Seal STS™ Renue'N'Seal™ - Premium Grout Colourant.
